Sub:- Supply of bamboo to Burood Societies - Procedure  
to be followed - regarding.

In the above reference government has permitted the supply of bamboo to the members of Burood Cooperative Societies and Cooperative Societies of other weaker Sections whose members are traditionally engaged in the manufacture of articles from bamboos, at a rate of Rs. 18.75 per 100 bamboos excluding extraction charges. As per the item (ii) of the G.O. let cited, each member of the cooperative society shall be supplied 600 bamboos per annum per member of which 300 will be whole bamboos and 300 split bamboos. To regularise and ensure proper supply to the members of the societies the following procedure is prescribed,

The list of members of each society recommended for supply of bamboo to be obtained from the Assistant Director of Industries, Commerce & Export Promotion concerned at the beginning of the each year of supply. Each member of the society should obtain a certified identification card to facilitate supply of bamboo from the Assistant Director of Industries, Commerce & Export promotion concerned in the enclosed proforma. Before the supply of bamboos to the individual members is started, identify card should be attested by the Divisional Forest Officer indicating the depot ( or coupe) from where the bamboo are to be supplied to the member.

A register shall be maintained by the officer incharge of the depot ( or coupe) showing the details of supply of whole bamboos and split bamboos made to the member on different dates, and the amount paid by the member. This register shall be checked by the concerned Range Officer and Divisional Forest Officer whenever they visit the places and ensure that the members are assured of regular supply of bamboos to continue their traditional professions. Care should be taken to see that the bamboo supplied are utilised by the members by themselves or their family members to manufacture the bamboo goods.

In the subsequent years bamboos may be supplied on the same card after obtaining renewal from the concerned Asst. Director of Industries, Commerce & Export promotion.

These orders will come into effect with immediate effect.
