Sub:- Raising Plantation of Trees yielding oil seeds  
under Tree Plantation/Afforestation programme-Reg.

It has been decided to raise concentrated plantations of trees yielding oil seeds on (1) Road Avenues (2) Shelter Belts or Wind belts (3) Canal Banks and (4) Suitable Patches in Reserved Forests. The species suggested are Neem, Pongamia, Bassia and Perennial Castor etc.

All the Working Plan Officers are hereby directed to include these prescription under miscellaneous regulations while preparing the working plans.
