In supercession of the instructions issued in Chief Conservator of Forests reference cited on the above subject and consequent to the implementation of the scheme of localisation cadres in respect of Non-gazetted losts in Forest Department under six point formula as a proved in G.O.Ms.No. 612/Forests & Rural Development (3PF) Dept. dt. 3-7-76, the following offices of the Forest Dept. are declared as special offices / Establishments, State level offices / Institutions tions.

and that the posts in these divisions offices, are to be filled by drafting persons from each of the zonal cadres in respect of Pange Officers, Circle cadres in respect of Dy. Range Officers, Foresters and below, from Divisional cadres on equitable basis in such ratio as may be rescribed by the Chief Conservator of Forests from time to time on tenure basis for a period of not exceeding 2 years at a time. From basis for a period of not exceeding 3-years at a time. From this it is clear that for filling up of the posts in these special division offices, no direct recruitment to these posts by the special division offices being the unit officers, is resorted to be these posts are to be filled by drafting the persons from either local or adjacent territorial division offices, who are the Unit Officers for the respective territorial divisions, or to be filled up by direct recruitment
by the Unit officers (Territorial divisions). These instructions should be kept in view, whenever the vacant posts
