DEPARTMENTAL TEST FOREST LAW (Short Notes)

Cattle Pound:

It is a place where all cattle such as Cows, Bulls, Buffaloes, Horses, Mules, Asses, Pigs, Sheep, Goats etc. will, if found trespassing in a Reserved Forest or in a protected forest doing damage to a public plantation will be seized and impounded. Such a pound will be established by the District Magistrate of the District in a village (Sections 3 and 4 of the Cattle Trespass Act).

Cattle Pound:-

The District Magistrate has the power i) to decide on the place where the pounds are to be established and the villages to be served by such pounds (Sec.4 cattle Tr. Act) ii) to fix the rates of charges for feeding and watering the cattle from time to time (S.5) to appoint suspend or remove pound keepers (S.6). A pound keeper is deemed to be a public servant and may hold other offices of profit.
