CIRCULAR NO. 17/79

Sub:- Establishment - Forest Department - Executive and
Ministerial staff - Drafting of - on tenure basis
to the special duty posts in R & D Circle & P.F.
Circle - Instructions - Issued.

In this office reference 1st cited, detailed instructions were issued wherein the procedure as to filling up of the posts vacant in special officers Special Establishments, State wide institutions etc., by way of drafting the personnel from the territorial Divisions to these posts on tenure basis from out of the panels approved, has been prescribed. After issue of the above instructions in a circular form, the Government have issued orders in the reference 2nd cited approving the amendment to the A.P. Forest Subordinate Service Rules which envisages the drafting of personnel to the special duty posts in Research and Development Circle and Project Formulation Circle.

Now the Conservator of Forests, Research & Development Circle in his ref.No. 1339/79/E2 dt: 18-3-1979 has stated that some of the employees were appointed in the special offices such as working plan parties and State Silviculturist Divisions originally and were also confirmed in the special division prior to declaring them as special divisions under the provisions of Six Point Formula and that their liens are maintained in the special divisions. After enforcement of the provisions of Six Point Formula, the Conservator of Forests has stated that under the R&D Circle and P.F. Circle, all are the special divisions and that the staff in these divisions have to be posted by drafting the subordinate staff from the various territorial divisions depending upon the places of their requirements and works and that the employees drafted from the other divisions are having their lien in their parent divisions and circles. The Conservator of Forests has therefore stated that as the employees appointed originally in special divisions, cannot have any prospect for promotion etc., unless they are attached the same territorial division for circle for the purposes of promotion etc. The Conservator of Forests, R & D Circle has requested to clarify as to whether the Foresters and Reserve Watchers, L.D.C. are to be attached to the territorial divisions and Circle for the purpose of panels of promotion.

After careful examination of the matter, it is held that consequent to the enforcement of Amendment to the special Rules for A.P. Forest Subordinate Services vide G.O.Ms.No. 374 R&RD (SPF) dated 26-5-1978 with effect from 18-10-1975 and also as per CCF's Circular No. 4/78 dated 3-3-1978 only drafting of personnel for

For the purpose of promotion from Forester to Dy. Range Officer, the concerned territorial Conservator of Forests has to prepare the pannels not only in respect of the Foresters of his Circle but also in respect of the Foresters working in special offices/Special establishment/State wide Institutions which were originally appointed in such offices prior to enforcement of the amended rules to A.P. Forest Subordinate Services. Regarding the staff drafted for such special divisions, they should however be considered in their parent circle.

It is also noticed that certain staff originally appointed in special offices in clear vacancies are reported to be not yet confirmed although these special offices as certain permanent posts under certain categories. The Heads of such Special Offices are requested to take immediate action to get the persons originally appointed in these divisions confirmed in those vacancies as per rules.
