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Six Forests - Departmental Extraction Scheme - Supply
of agricultural implements etc. to local people sale
at beat head quarters - Regarding.

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Attention of all the Conservators of Forests
territorial and Logging Circles is invited to the references cited,
orders of Government directing that small quantity of timber and
fire wood be sold to local people by the Divisional Forest
Officers concerned for the purpose of agricultural implements
and fuel at convenient places at the rates fixed by the
Conservators of Forests concerned.

In the references 2nd to 4th cited, the Conservators
of Forests were requested for fixing rates for the above items
for the year and also for giving wide publicity by notifying
in the District Gazettes etc. with a view to see that the local
people avail the opportunity of purchasing their requirements of
agricultural implements at reasonable rates at convenient places
without going to the distant timber depots.

In this connection, it is stated that in the recent
meeting of Hon'ble Minister for Forests at Jannaram, it was decided
to make arrangements for supply of agricultural implements to
local ryots at the Forest Guards' head quarters.

In view of the above and with a view to provide
facility to local ryots to get their requirement of agricultural
implements conveniently and easily, all the Conservators of
Forests are hereby instructed to issue necessary instructions to
their concerned Divisional Forest Officers to take immediate
necessary action to arrange the sale of agricultural implements
to the local ryots at each beat head quarters also in their
divisions. The quantity of the material to be displayed at
each centre can be decided after taking an inventory of all
villages in the beat.

The receipt of this circular should be acknowledged
immediately.
