SOVERIMENT OF ANDULA PRADESH FORZST DEPARTARNE

Ref: - 1. Minutes of the meeting h La on 27.4.1975 and 28.4.1976 at Hyderabad (Communicated in CC's Jr. No. 52678/76-V3 dt. 7.5.1976.

In the very early implementation of Departmental Extraction Scheme (i.s. in the year .1976) it was impressed on Conservators of Forests that tenders should be called for transport of timber through press, and finalised for the entire Circle, so that there is no disparity between rates adopted in neighbouring divisions. The Conservators of Forests were also advisted to call for tenders in the dase of transport, and the Divisional Forest Officers in other cases.

Even after issue of instructions in the reference Ist cited, the Additional Chief Conservator of Forests (A&ST) in an enquiry on allegation against one Divisional Forest Officer, has observed that transportation of Departmental extracted timber is being done without calling for tenders. He has also ob-served that no serious efforts have been made to engage carts for transportation of timber,, where the lead is short to effect economy.

The Conservators of Forests Divisional Forest Officers are therefore directed to go through the instructions issued in the references cited and:

- 1) To call for tenders for all works involving huge expenditure by the Conservators of Forests in the case of transport, and Divisional Forest Officer in other cases.
- 2) every effort should be made to transport timber by
- carts where the lead is short, and
 3) the Divisional Forest Officer should himself undertake the payments by choques where individual payments are huge.

The circular instructions issued should strictly be followed.
