CIRCULAR NO. 12 82-H2

Sub:- MOTOR VEHICLE- Repairs an Replacements to Government Vehicles -Prior Permission from the concerned Addl. Chief Conservators of Forests to carry out the repairs and replacements Submission of proposals to the Chief Conservator of Forests for sanction in time-Regarding.

Ref: State Transport Authorit, Hyderabad Circular Memo.No. 30745/G3/76 Dt. 27.8.19 communicated in C. C. F's Endt.No. 126375/76-H2 2t. 29.9.177.

It is noted that many proposals are being received from various Divisional Forest Officers especially at fag end of financial year requesting offost factor sanction and also ratification Orders for the expenditure incurred by them sometimes after 1 or 2 years on some plea or other. In such of the cases forwarded to the Government from this office the Government have been very critical and pointed out lapses calling for reasons for delay in submitting proposals for Post factor sanction etc. Thus, it has become aheadache to the Chief Conservator of Forests all the while giving replies to the Government to justify such cases. It is not understood as to why the Divisional Forest Officers are submitting their proposals after a lapse of 1 or 2 years and the reasons for such delay and their difficulties for submitting the proposals before competent authority for saction intime. It is to be construed that the delay occurs only due to lack of timely pursuance and lethorgy in such of the matters. This has to be put to an end from now onwards (Financial year 1982-33).

- 2. Further it is also noticed that some of the Conservator of Forests and Divisional Forest Officers are submitting their proposals with the bills scrutinised and passed for payment by the Motor Vehicle Inspector or Asst. Motor Vehicle Inspector concerned even when the expenditure incurred towards repairs and replacements exceeds Rs. 1000/- . In the reference cited (Circular instructions of State Transport Authority) it was clearly stated that if the expenditure exceeds to Ms. 1000 towards Repairs and Replacements of Government Vehicles, the bills must invariably be scrutinised and passed for payment by the legional Transport Officer concerned. Therefore all the Conservators of Torests and Divisional Forest Officers are instructed to put an one to the type of practice hereafter and submit their proposals to the deief Conservator of Forests in correct Form Keeping lavies to above instructions without delay. There is also in their justification giving the necessity if repairs especially where here yearditure is involved.
- 3. As such all officers are hereby instructed to submit their proposals to the Chief Conservator of Forests through the concerned Adal. Chief Conservator of Forests for semection of the expenditure incurred by them towards Repairs and Replacements as detailed below:-

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- 1. 1. Venicles (Jeeps, tractors, lorries) of Logging Divisions under D.E.T. works Flying Squad Divisions Bood Leaves Schemes through the Addl. Chief Conservator of Forests (DE. & V.)
 - 2. Vehicles under Wildlife Management and G me sancturies, 700s through the Addl. Chief Conservator of Forests (WL. & A)
 - 3. Vehicles under Social Forestry and D.P.A.P. Works through the Addl. Chief Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry).
 - 4. Vehicles of Divisional Forest Officers Territorial Working Plan Offices, and S.S. through the Addl. Chief Conservator of Ferests (Aum. T.).

All the Officers are requested to note that no proposals will be entertained in this office, if they are not forwarded through their concerned Addl. Chief Conservators of Forests for sanction. They are instructed to obtain Prior Permission and written approval from their concerned Addl. Chief Conservator of Forest's before incurring any expenditure on repairs and replacements and then only approach the Chief Conservator of Forests for sanction. All the formalties should be completed within One(1) or latest (2) months from the date of completion of the work. They should also note that no post facto sanctions will be entertained hereafter in this office without prior written approval of the Addl. Chief Conservator of Forests concerned. Any proposal received without fulfilling the formalties stated supra, will be simply returned back to them and the officers concerned will only be responsible for any delay and consequences.

All the Conservators of Prests are advised to Counter-check the proposals received from the Divisional Farest Officers concerned carefull and correct defects noticed at their end itself before submitting them to the concerned Addl. Chief Conservator of Forests for approval who will in turn forward to the Chief Conservator of Forests for sanction. The above instructions should be strictly adhered to from 1-4-1982 enwards.

The receipt of the Circular should be acknowledged by return of Post.
