Sub: - Working of Departmental Extraction Scheme-Instructions-Issued-Reg.

During the meeting of Conservator of Forests on 18.8.1983, at Hyderabad some of the Conservators of Forests have informed that the 1983-84 coupes have not yet taken up for extraction as enumeration etc., has not yet completed. It means, about 4 to 5 months of working period is lost in preliminaries only. This restricts the working period to hardly six months in a given year. This may be one of the reasons for slippage in physical targets, heavy spillover of material at the end of financial year etc., in this regard the following instructions are issued.

- 1. Marking and enumeration should be taken up from January or even earlier, if any, and completed by the end of February for all the areas proposed to be worked in ensuiing financial year. All coupes proposed to be worked should begin accordance with the prescriptions of the current working plan Deviation if any shouldbe got approved by the competent authority well in advance.
- 2. In the 1st fortnight of March, the Departmental Extraction staff should take possession of all the proposed areas and start working of the areas in the first week of April without fail.
- 3. In first week of April the Logging Divisional Forest Office should report to the Conservator of Forests and the Chief Conservator of Forests by talegram that he has taken possession of 11 the areas proposed for working during the year.
- 4. The Logging Divisional Forest Officers are personally responsible to see the extraction work starts in April itself in the areas proposed for working. The extraction work should be so planned that the work is evenly spread over all the months of the year.

5. If there is any spillover material of previous year to be extracted and transported it should be attended to first and completed in April itself, under report to Conservator of Forests/Chief Conservator of Forests, with full details.

6. Any deviation for these instruction will be viewed seriously on the concerned officers will be liable for suitable disciplinary action.
