Sub: - Grant of House Rent allowance in lieu of compensatory allowance in taluk towns a to the employees working in Rural areas - instructions - issued.

In the GO 4st cited, Gövernment have ordered that employees working at the head quarters of taluks and subtaluks are in Municipalities and Municipal towns, be allowed House Rent allowance @ 4% of pay in lieu of compensatory allowance. This GO was communicated to all the officers in GCLs Ref No 8336/80-CSUdt 17 7783 CC's Ref.No.8336/80-C2, dt:17.7.80.

In the Govt. neno 2nd cited, Govt have clarified that the HRA @ 4% of pay in lieu of CA is only admissble to the employees working at the Head Quarters of taluks and subtaluks and Municipal towns and it does not apply to the apple-yees working in the offices situated within a distance of 8 kms from the periphery of the taluk towns. The above Govt. nemo was also communicated to all officers in CC's Rc.No. 43944/80/C2.dt.13.6383 43944/80/C2, dt:13.6.83.

Subsequently Government in their G.M.No.42852/B/46//PRC.180-1., dtL17.12.80 have further clarified that*the HRA @ 4% of pay shall also be admissible to the employees whose places of duty are in villages/towns whose revenue/municipal limits are within a distance of 8 km from the peripheri of the HGS of taluks and sub-taluks or Municipalities and Municipal towns. However HRA is not admissible to those who are provided rent free accomodation quarters or payd quarters. The above 40 was communicated to all officers in CC's Ref.14372/81 62 and dt:15.4.83. Subsequently Government in their G.M.No.42852/B/467/PRC.I.

Again Government is their GO Ms.No.5, Finance & Flg Dept dated: 7.1.83 issued latest orders that the HRA 4% be allowed to all the employees working in the rural areas where no HRA is admissble under the existing orders. This GO has also been communicated to all the officers in Ref. 3782/83-C2, 22.2.83.

During the conference of Junior Forest Officers held in at CC's office on 24.10.83 it was complained that Forest Subordinate Officers working in the rural areas are not paid. HRA @ 4% and thus they are lossing the benefit of HRA.

It is not understood why the HRA is not claimed and paid to the Forest suboridinate officers working in the Rural areas inspite of clear Govt. Orders communicated to all officers from time to time as noted above. Hence all the officers are hereby instructed once again that the HRA shouldbe drawn and paid without fail and see that no such complaints are received in future non-implementation of the GOs and CC's instructions will be dealt with a size of the contractions. will be dealt with seriously.
