Sub: DEPARTMENTAL EXTRACTION SCHEME - Checking of Fuelwood stacks - Certain instructions - Issued.

Due to introduction of Departmental Extraction Scheme, the extraction work and the sale of the produce are entrusted to the Logging Divisional Forest Officers are ontrusted to the Logging Divisional Forest Officers for botter management and to achieve prompt results. Accordingly, the extraction work should be rationally distributed amongst the Logging Divisional Forest Officers, Range Officers and Foresters, without leaving the matter entirely to the care of Range Officers and Foresters.

There must be coordination and systamatic check of the extracted produce right from the Foresters, Range Officers and by Divisional Forest Officer, Logging Divisions.

The work of extraction and sale of the fuelwood stacks should be completed as nor the approved programme by the should be completed as por the approved programme by the Conservators of Forests.

All fuelwood stacks extracted must be verified All Tuelwood stacks extracted must be verilled thoroughly by the concerned Forester. The Range Officer should also check all the fuelwood stacks before sales and furnish a certificate as to the actual number of stacks and the total value. stacks and the total volume. The Logging Divisional Forest Officers should physically verify the stacks put up for sale.
