Discharge of a probationer:
"Discharge of a probationer" means, in case the probationer is a full member or an approved probationer of another service, class category, reviring him to such service, class or category and in any other case, dispensing with his services.

FULL MEMBERS:'Full member' of a service means a member of that service who has been absointed substantively to a permanent post borne on the cadre thereof;

(Vide Rule 3 (8) of A.P. State & Subordinate Services Rules)

PROBATIONER: - "Probationer" in a service means a member of that service who has not completed his probation.
