Sub:- Establishment - Posting and Transfers to and from
the Social Forestry Wing - Regarding.

Ref:- G.O.Rt.No.244 F&FD (For.II) Dept., dt:8-3-1984

Government in the G.O.cited have issued orders, that all matters relating to Establishment, disciplinary cases and vigilance etc., relating to Social Forestry Wing, shall be dealt by the Chief Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry)/ Addl.Chief Conservator of Forests (S.F) only. Hither to all proposals for posting, transfers etc., to Social Forestry Wing are being dealt by the Chief Conservator of Forests (G) on proposals submitted to him by the territorial Conservators in consultation with the Conservator of Forests, Social Forestry Circle concerned. In all such cases, the Chief Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry) is almost unaware of either the proposals and at the time even the orders issued by the Chief Conservator of Forests (General) posting and transferring executive and Ministerial staff from the territorial circles and divisions to Social Forestry Circles and Divisions or vice versa.

In order that the Chief Conservator of Forests (S.F) can better perform the duties and responsibilities assigned to him now relating to establishment matters in the Social Forestry wing, it is necessary that copies of the proposals submitted to the territorial Conservators of Forests (after discussing the same with the Social Forestry Conservator of Forests and as mutually agreed to) to the Chief Conservator of Forests (G) be sent to the Chief Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry) so that the later can if necessary pursue the same with the Chief Conservator of Forests (General) for issue of earlier orders on same. The Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry) Circles should submit all proposals for transfer, posting etc to the Divisions/ Circle offices under these when arising in their offices, only to the Chief Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry) in duplicate, so that one copy could be forwarded by him to the Chief Conservator of Forests (General) with his remarks for orders. It is needless to mention that all such proposals should have been discussed by the Conservator of Forests (S.F) with the territorial Conservator of Forests concerned and are mutually agreed to.

4. These instructions should be followed scrupulously in future.
