Government is attaching muchimportance forsupply ofbambood Burcods and other Weaker Sections who are traditionally engage manufacturing articles from bamboos. In this connection detailed tructions were issued vide references list and 2nd cited regarded quantity of material to be supplied, the percentage of round an applit bomboo, checking of accounts by Industries Department and Forest Department Officers etc. In some of the Circles, additabamboo coupes are also being worked departmentally to meet this increased demand.

In the reference 3rd cited, Conservators of Forests were requested to submit a report regarding the number of society mor quantity supplied in each circle, yearwise. Some of the Conservator of Forests have submitted and some are yet to submit with the Chief Conservator of Forests is not posted with uptodate information regarding the number of Societies, membership and bamboos supplied. It may be quite possible that at Circle level also such information may not be readily available. This information is required as the supply of bamboos to Buroods and otherWeaker Sections is a matter of Great importance. Foreffective implementation of the Government orders thefollowing procedure is suggested.

I. A register should be opened and information posted upto the at the end of the every month by obtaining information from the divisions concerned. Since this is a human problem, prompt action should be taken supplying the material etc., and the Flying squad and other ritorial staff may be directed to keep a constant vigil so as ansure that the material reaches the beneficiries promptly.

The Divisional Forest Officers are also requested to check the accounts of the Societies frequently as per the powers deligated in G.O.Ms.No. 439, Forests and Rural Development (For. III a)
