at is generally seen that the Conservators of Forests sending proposals for extension of the suspension period fter the first suspension period is over, or it is just be to expire in a week or so. There are clear instructions of the Government that the extension proposals for the suspension period have to be submitted to the Government that the expire of the suspension period. This ne month before the expiry of the suspension period. This cans that the Principale Chief Conservator of Forests have submit the extension proposals one month before the expiry the suspension period. Which is not being done because proposals are being received from the Conservators of cests very late. It is htherefore in the interest of the conservators of Forests and Divisional Forest Officers that he proposals for continueation of suspension should be acceived in the Office of Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests at least 45 days before the expiry of the first suspension period.

It is also noticed that the subordinates are being placed under suspension and no charge sheets are issued even after the expiry of 6 months period. This is a very serious lapse on the part of the Officers who place the subordinates under suspension.

The Government are of the view that in all matters excepiring cases involving misappropriation, and Antior and threrefore requested to bear this in mind and cessary instructions to the Divisional Forest Officers that in all cases the disciplinary proceedings are papleted before the 6 months period is over. Naturally in ases wich are of misappropriation of under enquiry by ini-Corruption Bureau proposals for extension should invariably be sent to the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests theast 45 days in advance, so that the proposals for wtension could be submitted to Government by the Prl.Chief inscription of Forests one month before the expiry of the mension period.

The Conservators of Forests are also requested to give full justification for the extension of suspension period and also the stage at which the disciplinary cases are pending, so that the Government may not raise any asjection. Violation of these instructions will be reviewed seriously.
