Sub: Industries- Setting up of Industries in A.P. Environmental  
clearance of Industries from Forestry angle - Instructions-  
issued- Reg.

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The Department of Environmenta Government of Andhra Pradesh Hyderabad is forwarding proforma particulars industries proposed to be set up near Reserve Forests, Ecologically sensitive areas etc. with a request to give site clearance certificate from environmental angle for establishment of the proposed Industry/ factory in the areas selected by the industrialists/enterpre- tueres. Such cases are being referred to the Forest Department for environmental clearance of said industries from forest angle.

Limitation of a certain distance from the Reserved Forest areas for setting up of industries is considered need- sary to avoid adverse impact on the Reserve Forest or ecolo- gically sensitive areas. However to obtain a complete overall picture of the impact of such an industry be set up near the Reserve Forest it is necessary to obtain data from the field.

Keeping in view the above facts and objects of Forest (Cons) Act, 1980, a CHECK SLIP is prepared to facilitate the forest officials to inspect personally the site proposed/ selected by the industrialists for establishment of industry/ factory and to study the environmental impacts in case of establishment of such industries from forests angle and to submit their reports in the proforma for issuing a certificate from this department. A copy of the check slip is enclosed as annexure to this circular for information and necessary action. The check slip is not ex- haustive. It may added to wherever necessary.

The Conservator of Forests Forests and Divisional Forest Officer are there requested to keep in view the above facts and the particulars in the check slip whenever remarks are called for environmental clearance of industries from forestry angle and submit their reports with check slip duly filled in each case for sending report to Government within 15 days from the date of receipt of the case referred to them.

The receipt of the circular should be acknowledged by return of post.

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PROFORMA PARTICULARS REQUIRED FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE OF  
INDUSTRIES FROM FORESTRY ANGLE.

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1. Name of the Industry
2. Geographical Location (Mandal Village Sy.No.etc.)
3. Whether located within the R.F. or outside (if inside R.F. give details).
4. If located outside the R.F. shortest / straight line/ distance from nearest R.F?
5. Type of Industry (light/medium/heavy) (Describe the process and nature of effluents and proposed treatment before letting into atmosphere, if possible).
6. Whether the effluents (gaseous liquid and solid) will be passing through R.F./affecting flora, fauna if so nature of effect.
7. Whether there is any proposal for construction of residential colony for the workers to be employed in the industry. If so location and distance from nearest R.F.
8. How many workers are to be employed/ reside in the factory/ colony ( population details occupation wise within factory and colony)
9. Whether the garbage dumps, mud and waste products are going to be deposited within the R.F. or into water courses passing through RFs if not proposed mode of disposal of solid wastes.
10. Are there any water courses passing through RF into which effluents are likely to flow?
11. (a) Type of forests? Density of forest?  
: (b) Major species of fauna found in the R.F. located within 5 Kms.
12. What is the likely affect of pollutants (Gaseous, liquid and solid) on the flora and fauna.
13. Please list out:-
  - a) What will be the impact of the factory workers over the RF (Flora & Fauna) particularly for their requirements of fuel, fodder and small timber.
  - b) What steps the company is taking to meet the energy needs of the its employees both permanent and temporary.
14. Whether any explosives will be used within 5 Kms. from RF boundary and sensitive areas (a) during building (b) during normal working.

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
