It is generally seeb that, of late the Divisional Forest Ufficers are sending the proposals for extension of suspension of subordinates by the concerned officers, that the initial date of suspension of the individuals was not furnished. For consideration of proposals for extension of suspension by the Government details regarding late of initial suspension, how long the person has been under suspension, why the enquiry cannot be completed within the period stipulated etc., are required. pending in courts etc. efforts should be made through Govt. Pleader concerned for expeditious disposal of such cases. In respect of cases The proposals for extension of suspension shall contain details of efforts made in that regard in those cases. It appears departmental enquiries and consequential suspension of Forest subordina es in several cases are unduly prolonged years together without marking due efforts for completing the enquiries promptly by the departmental officers. Even in cases where the individuals are liable for severe punishments, if enquiries and consequential punishments are delayed, it will not have the desired effect Government view that a pariod of six months should be sufficient for comploting the enquiry in any disciplinary case and the enquiry should not be prolunged more than that period, except in some special/exceptional cases.

Unlessful details of the case like initial date of suspension, reasons for delay in completion of enquiry etc., are furnished to the Government with full justification for extension of suspension, proposals for extension of suspension period will be not be approved by the Government in future.
