Sub:- M.D.O. reports of the C.Fs - Revised Standardised proforma - Communicated - Regd.

In Prl. Chief Conservator of Forest's Circular No. 2/77 and subsequent Circulars 2/a/77, 2/b/77, 2/c/77 and 2/d/77, the Conservators of Forests were requested to submit M.D.O. reports duly incorporating various aspects of Forests' administration in each circle so as to assess the problems and performance of each Circle. Standard proforma was also communicated to them with a request to highlight their activities under various headings.

A revised proforma of M.D.O. is formulated based on the confidential reports, proforma of A.I.S. Officers and also based on Circular instructions of this office. A copy of the same is enclosed herewith.

Under heading Protection of Forests and Wild Life the Conservators of Forests are requested to furnish the following information.

- a) Major destruction if reported any- (full details to be furnished)
- b) Areas encroached during the period under report (Progressive total of area encroached should also be mentioned)

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Under the heading Progress of Development works (Plan/Non-Plan), the Conservators of Forests are requested to furnish details under each scheme separately, and salient points in Departmental Extraction as per Prl. Chief Conservator of Forest's Circular No. 14/1987. They are also requested to furnish progress of scheme completion reports and details of extracts and sales.

Under the heading Field Inspections and Results, the Conservators of Forests are requested to furnish details as per Prl. Chief Conservator of Forest's Circular No. 14/1987 in respect of Departmental Extraction. The Conservators of Forests need not enclose Inspection reports.

Under the heading Inspection of Forest blocks, the Conservators of Forests are requested to inspect two blocks every month and comment upon general protection, state boundaries, encroachments if any and other salient features, relating to Silvicultural Management and Wild life.

The M.D.O. of 3rd month should contain a review of Forest Protection, Wild Life, Nature of offences, pattern of smuggling, Vehicles involved etc. The Conservators of Forests are also requested to conduct quarterly meeting on this subject like Police Department where they conduct monthly crime cases.

Under the heading Inspection of Old Plantations the Conservators of Forests are requested to inspect old Plantations more than 3 years old in one or two ranges every month, and make a mention of the same regarding their condition, survival percentage and its management.

The Conservators of Forests are requested to submit their future M.D.O. reports on the revised proforma with effect from December, 1989. They may submit the M.D.O. to Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, Chief Conservator of Forests (S.F) and Chief Conservator of Forests (M) only, and the contents should be such that they should give clear and overall picture of the forest activities in Circle.
