CIRCULAR NO.19/90/H2.

Sub:-MOTOR VEHICLES- Condemned Vehicles-Fully
confiscated vehicles accorded permission for
their disposal procedure for sale calling of
tenders system - orders-issued.

Hitherto the procedure for disposal of condemned
or fully confiscated vehicles which have been ordered for
disposal was to conduct open auction system by giving wide
publicity in daily local news papers giving therein the
conditions of the sale. The sale will go in favour of the
highest bidder. The sale however commences from upset
price i.e., the value of the vehicle fixed by Motor Vehicles
Inspector.

Of late, it is noticed, that this system of open auction
sale at times is resulting in not getting expected revenue
to the Government. It is seen that at times vehicles are
sold equal to the price of upset price fixed by Motor
Vehicle Inspector. Some times even being sold for lesser
price than that of the upset price. The only reasons that
is put forth for this is, that no bidder is forthcoming,
despite vehicle being put for sale on two or three occasions.

With a view to fetch maximum revenue to Government, it is
decided that instead of open sale system, the system of
sale by calling for tenders is introduced by wide publicity
in local news papers and one or two important papers for
disposal of condemned or fully confiscated vehicles which
are accorded permission for disposal hence forth. If the
amounts offered are less than the upset price then they
should conduct open sale.

The receipt of the circular should be acknowledged.
