Sub:-Trainings - Trainings in Social Forestry on
various Institutes of A.P.State-Poor Attendance-
Instructions.

Training programmes on Social Forestry are being con-
ducted in the Institute such as N.I.R.D., E.E.I., S.I.R.D.
Extension Training Institute at Dullapally etc. Officers of
various levels have been drafted and have undergone courses
since, 1986-87 in the above mentioned institutes.

It is observed that some officers are not attending
these trainings inspite of orders from this office to attend
the trainings without fail. They are seeking exemptions on
some plea or the other. Controlling officers also are
often recommending such cases without giving any serious
thought. It is brought to their notice that trainings in
other Institute including our own Institute at Dullapally are
being conducted at enormous cost and candidates failing
to attend the course results in loss of time and money. It
also upsets the overall training schedule as each course
is meant for fixed number of candidates.

The Conservators of Forests, Research and Training
Circle, Hyderabad has reported that in the year, 1989-90
itself about 30 to 40 officers have not attended various
trainings in the Institutes at Dullapally, Extension Educa-
tion Institute, National Institute of Rural Development etc.

The very purpose of these trainings is to develop
and improve knowledge by interaction with visiting lecturers
who are experts in their fields and also by exchange of views
amongst themselves for implementation in the field.

In view of the above the officers and staff of
Forest Department are hereby instructed to attend the
training whenever drafted without fail and no request for
exemption for any reason will be entertained in future.
If any officer fails to obey these instructions and obtain
from training they will be dealt with seriously. In
extreme and unavoidable circumstances, when any officer

is not able to attend the concerned Conservator of Forests or Divisional Forest Officer should obtain prior permission and suggest alternate candidate in the respective circle or Divisions. They should contact the Chief Conservator of Forests (S.F) by sending telegram or on phone and obtain orders.

The Conservator of Forests, Research and Training Circle, Hyderabad is requested to intimate the names of defaulters henceforth for initiating disciplinary action.

These instructions will take immediate effect. The Conservators of Forests and Divisional Forest Officers are directed to take proper action.
