CIRCULAR NO.6/90/A2.

Sub:-Estt.-F.D -Promotion of the individuals in
all categories with retrospective effect on
par with their juniors-Relaxation of rule
33(a) of A.P.S.&S.S.Rules in favour of indi-
viduals-Proposals-submitting-Regarding.

All the Conservators of Forests and Divisional Forest
Officers are informed that the individuals i.e. Deputy
Range Officers, Foresters, Forest Guards and Reserve Watchers
who were not selected and promoted to next higher posts in
the panels due to their record of service etc., by their
concerned officers, are submitting appeal petitions to the
next higher authorities for their promotion with retrospec-
tive effect on par with their juniors promoted overlooking
them.

2. The correct procedure to be followed in such cases
is that the individual who was not selected for promotion
to next cadre by the competent authority, has to submit an
appeal petition to next higher authority within a period of
(6) months as per the provisions of rule G.R.35 of A.P.S.S.
of Ministerial Service Rules. Then the appellate authority
has to decide whether the appeal is to be allowed or rejected
and if appeal is upheld to issue a speaking provisional
order indicating the decision.

3. If the appeal is allowed by the appellate authority,
show cause notices should be issued under rule 35 of A.P.S.&
S.S.Rules to the persons likely to be affected by the provi-
sional order and obtain their acknowledgements. In the
show cause notice, the provisional decision of the appella-
te authority must be mentioned in detail and the persons
likely to be affected by the provisional decision, should
be given an opportunity to prefer appeals if any over the
provisional decision. Such appeals should also be addressed
to the appellate authority. The appellate authority may
consider such appeals preferred by the individuals likely
to be affected by the provisional decision and decide
whether to accept or reject them. If such appeals are
accepted, the provisional decision will have to be suitably
modified. If upon this and in case the appeals preferred
by the individuals likely to be affected by the provisional
decision are rejected if the appellant would be eligible
for promotion with retrospective effect, a self contained

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report should be made to the Govt. requesting for relaxation of Rule 33 (a) of A.P.State and Subordinate Service Rules and promotion of the appellant should be made with retrospective effect only after receipt of final orders from the Govt. relaxing Rule 33(a) of A.P.State and Subordinate Service Rules.

4. In some similar cases, it has been observed that the officers are not following the above procedure and are giving promotion to individuals with retrospective effect on par with their juniors pending relaxation of rule 33(a). Such promotions are irregular.

5. Hence, all the officers are requested to follow the procedure as detailed in paras 2 and 3 without fail.
