Operation - employment of tribals and rural
poor living in and around Forests - Instruc-
tions issued - Regarding.

The Government of India through their letter
No.13-1/90 FP (4) dated 18-9-1990 have issued guide
lines regarding elimination of intermediaries and payment
of fair wages to the labourer employed on forestry works.
These guidelines were communicated through this office
Ref.No.6633/87-J4, dated 12.11.1990.

Among other things, one of the requirement
under the guidelines is that tribal and rural poor
living in around forests alone should be employed in
the execution of different forestry operations. The
Government have also agreed this suggestion in principle.
Hence all Conservators of Forests / Divisional Forest
Officers are requested to see that local tribal and
rural poor living in and around forests alone shall be
employed in the execution of various forestry operations
in the different parts of the State.

The Conservators of Forests / Divisional Forest
Officers are requested to make it a point to inspect
the works during their terasand ensure the implementation
of the circular instructions in their true spirit.
