Attention of the Conservators of Forest / Divisional
Forest Officers is invited to the Circular 12/91 cited,
wherein it was requested to see that local tribal and
rural poor living in and around forests alone shall be
employed in the execution of various forestry operations
in the different parts of the State. They were also
requested to make it a point to inspect the works during
their tours in their respective jurisdictions and ensure
the implementation of the circular instructions in their
true spirit.

During the inter departmental meeting with social
Welfare Department it has been brought to the notice that
there are instances of departure in the implementation
of the said instructions particularly by the paper mills
in the forestry operations being executed in tribal areas.

The Conservators of Forests/Divisional Forest
Officers are therefore requested to see that besides the
departmental works the paper mills also employ the tribals
and other poor labour living in and around the forests in
their works in future as per the above said instructions.
