Sub:- Treating the period on duty when a subordinate
is hospitalised due to assault while dis-
charging duties - Regarding.

...

The A.P. Junior Forest Officers Association has
represented that in some Divisions, the Forest Subordinates,
who were subjected to assaults while discharging their
official duties, were asked to apply for leave to which
they are eligible, for the period during which they were
unable to attend duties due to injuries/hospitalisation.
The Association has requested the Prl. Chief Conservator
of Forests to treat such period as on duty and pay full
and allowances.

In this connection, all the officers are requested
to submit necessary proposals, whenever such incidents occur,
by enclosing the following documents, so that the Government
will be addressed to accord permission to treat such period
as on duty according to F.R. 83.

1. Detailed and self contained report of Divisional
Forest Officer/ Conservator of Forests on the
facts leading to assault/injury to the subordinate
and specific recommendation thereof.
2. A copy of the FIR lodged in the concerned Police
station and the correspondence made with the police
authorities.
3. Certificate issued by the concerned Hospital
Authorities not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon,
where the injured subordinate got admitted/treated.

All the officers are requested to acknowledge the
receipt of this reference by return of post.
