Sub:- Forest Department- Wild Life - Certin Works connected with Safari Parks at Nehru Zoological Park, Hyderabad-Reg. * * * *

On 3.9.1992, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Conservator of Forests (Wild Life) accompanied by the Conservator of Forests, Wild Life Management, Northern Circle, Hyderabad and Curator, Nehru Zoological Park, Hyderabad, inspected the Zoo Safari parks on the Safari Park Vehicles of the Nehru Zoological Park, Hyderabad.

The following directions were given after the inspections,

1. All the Safari Park Vehicles should be painted with Moss Green paint to match with the vegetative cover around and there should not be any names on them.

2. Strong metallic grills should be fixed effectively on all the openings windows of the Safari vehicles and also over the front and rear view mirror shields.

3. All latches from outside and inside the vehicles should be effectively working.

4. There should not be any broken glasses to the windows or the front and rear view shields.

5. The vehicles should have hooking mechanism for pulling them by means of other vehicles out in case of failure within the Safari Parks and the mechanism for their operation should be such that it will be from inside.

6. Every vehicle should have a guide (Zoo staff) who shall be seated in the seat next to the driver.

7. There should be mechanism for locking the vehicles from outside keeping the key with the driver and vehicles should be locked after the rounds when the vehicles come out the safari parks, the driver will be get down and open the lock allowing the visitors to get down.

8. The guide should have a walkie to be in touch with the Zoo staff outside for any emergency.

9. The guide also keep with him weapon with blank cartridges.

10. Crackers also shall be kept in lock and key with the driver in the vehicle for use in case of emergency to scare the Safari animals.

11. Each vehicle shall have a First Aid Box.

12. The Curator shall check up each and every item once in month and satisfy himself of the working conditions as listed above.

Until all the above items are attended to the Curator of Nehru Zoological Park is requested to close the Safari Parks for completing the above mentioned works and commission them after sending a compliance report.
