Sub:- A system for reporting W.L. offence cases – Regarding. Ref:- G.O.Lr.No.3-1/95-WL1, dated 29-8-1995.

Keeping in view the instructions issued by the Government of India in the reference cited. The following Circular instructions are issued to all the Conservators of Forests and Divisional Forest Officers.

In order to facilitate the process of obtaining information on offence cases and enable the Ministry of Environment to have regular access to information on Wild Life offence cases, it will be greatly appreciated if as a matter of regular practice, details of important cases (major cases, cases, involving wild life products most is demand, cases occurring in national parks/sanctuaries, cases involving habitual offenders etc.) are sent to the Ministry of Environment as soon as they are detected, along with a brief report as action taken on it. This will not only help them in replying to Parliament questions and queries from the press etc. but it will also help them to clarify the doubts being raised regarding Wildlife protection efforts in the Country.

Hence, all the Divisional Forest Officers and the Conservators of Forest are requested to follow the above instructions carefully and send their reports through this office immediately after detecting the offence cases, within a period of one week.
