Government Vehicles for smoke emission standards – one day Camp on
26-7-1998 – Regarding.

Government in their D.O. letter cited has informed that the Environmental Pollution with particular reference to vehicular pollution is included in the next Janma Bhoomi Programme starting from 1st August, 1998. To set an example, a Camp is being organised to check all vehicles of State, flying within M.C.H., limits on 26-7-1998 at Parade Grounds, Secunderabad for smoke emission standards. For all the vehicles that conform to the standards, specified in Central Motor Vehicular Rules, Pollution Under Control Certificates will be issued free of cost. Lunch is also arranged for all the drivers coming for inspection.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh will inaugurate the Camp at 9.30 a.m. on 26-7-1998. Hence all the Officers stationed at Hyderabad are requested to get all the vehicles under their control checked for smoke emission standards.

Hence all the Officers in the twin cities are requested to instruct their drivers to report at Parade Grounds, at 8.30 a.m. on Sunday the 26th July, 1998 along with vehicles with out fail.
